Annual Community Centre Pledge campaign. Our annual pledge campaign ended in March. We collected \$41,000 toward our goal of \$50,000 in contributions and pledges. Thank you to all who donated!

Volunteer of the Year. For 2017, the FICC "Volunteer of the Year" is Linda Burchfield. For Linda, it is more of a Lifetime Achievement award. She has been a great contributor during her time on the Board, including managing all the dinners and social events, and spearheading the efforts for the Treasure Sales, among lots of other contributions. Recycle. The Community Centre is recycling! We have placed containers outside the kitchen. Please help the environment and recycle your plastic, glass, and cans.

Clean - Up Day at the Community Centre. Saturday, May 5th, 8:00 a.m. Every year we try to shine up our beautiful Centre and Chapel. Some items that need attention include: windows cleaned, kitchen completely cleaned, dust the chapel, gutters cleaned out, power wash sidewalks and porches. Shred With Us will be here to securely shred outdated or unwanted papers containing personal information. Please go through your papers before bringing them to make sure that there is nothing included that would damage the shredder. Please, no CDs, videotapes, newspapers, cardboard, or any non-recyclable items. Paper clips and staples **ARE OK**, but please, no 3-ring binders.
