Library. Did you know that Fripp has a Library? It is located at the Community Centre, and is open from 8:00-5:00 Monday through Friday. We have a wide selection of books, books on tape, and DVDs. It is open for all to use, both residents and guests. The Library is called "Sandy's Library", in honor of longtime Librarian Sandy Buschur.

There is no checkout process; just come in, browse, and find the books you want. We ask a small 25 cent donation for each book you take, to help defray the costs of lights, etc. There is a small box in the Library for your monetary donations and a larger one for your book returns.

If you would like to donate items to the Library, please follow these guidelines. Due to limited space, we can only accept newer books (published since 2000, "classics" are excepted), DVDs, and books on CD. We no longer carry VHS tapes or music CDs. Also, we do not accept magazines or reference materials. If you would like to donate those items, you can contact other area organizations, such as the Beaufort County Library, the St. Francis Center, or Habitat for Humanity, among others. If you have jigsaw puzzles to donate, they can go to the Fripp Activity Center on Ocean Creek.
