Stained Glass window. Have you wondered about the history of our beautiful stained glass window in the chapel? It was created for us by BL Stained Glass of Jamestown, NC, in 1982. The specifications for the window, as noted by the Community Centre Board at the time, were "to combine the contemporary with the traditional, to show a feeling of upward movement, and to compliment [sic] the chapel colors and strong linear architecture." It cost the Community Centre \$1200. In 1986 it sustained some wind damage, and was removed, repaired, and replaced by BL Stained Glass.
