Dear Fripp Friends,

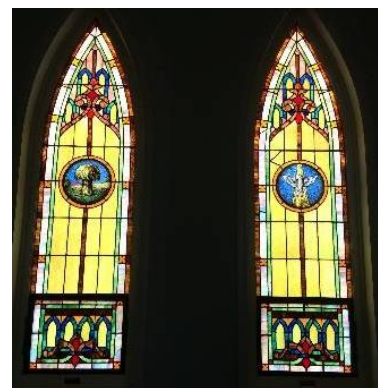
