Recycle/shredding. The Fripp Island Community Centre and the Fripp Island Women's Club are jointly sponsoring a **paper shredding and electronics recycling** event on **Saturday, May 18, from 9:00 am until 12:00 pm** in the Community Centre parking lot.

Shred With Us, a firm from Columbia, will be here to securely shred outdated or unwanted papers containing personal information. Bring any papers you want to dispose of to the Community Centre the morning of May 18th. If you need assistance unloading the papers from your car or golf cart, people will be available to help you. Mark your calendars now so you don't miss this opportunity to securely dispose of your outdated or unwanted personal papers! Please go through it before bringing it to make sure that there is nothing included that would damage the shredder. Please, no CDs, videotapes, newspapers, cardboard or any non-recyclable items. Paper clips and staples **ARE OK**, but please, no 3-ring binders.

Electronic equipment can be dropped off at the Centre for recycling at the Beaufort County special event that day. Any personal computers, laptops, CRT monitors, LCD monitors, CRT televisions, printers, hard drives and miscellaneous electronics (microwaves, lamps, cell phones, radios, fax machines, typewriters, etc.) will be accepted. Drop them off at the Community Centre from **9:00-12:00** on Saturday morning, **May 18**.
